Bailey Dance Company 2019-20 Info & Audition Form

About the dance company...

Bailey Dance Company is comprised of a small group of dancers (approximately 15-18 max) in Grades 6th, 7th, and 8th. The focus of Bailey Dance Company is to provide performance experiences in a variety of settings, community outreach, and possible registration for NCASA dance competition held for middle and high school students in our state, as well as other in and out of school community events through the school year

The dance company is designed for students that are already dancing at the intermediate and advanced levels in at least 1-2 technique areas: ballet, jazz, lyrical/contemporary, modern, and/or hip-hop. Students should be able to understand basic ballet/jazz dance terminology, be able to execute a right and/or left split, complete a variety of leaps/jumps, and basic turns (minimum double pirouette). This class will reiterate technique and form, however, students should already be familiar with proper placement, alignment, pointing toes, etc.

Students will be selected based on their audition and execution of dance elements, as well as their desire to pursue dance beyond the classroom and beyond middle school. The club will continue their work this year with special needs children, and explore dance in a variety of ways, outside of just performing. Ideal students will share in the desire to utilize their talent in order to help others, and cultivate their individual interests in dance.

NOTE: 7th & 8th Grade students who have been placed in the 7th & 8th Grade Performance Dance are welcomed & invited to audition and DO NOT REQUIRE A RECOMMENDATION FORM. 6th Grade students & NON 7th & 8th Performance Dance Students are invited to audition, however, will be required to complete additional recommendation forms.

There is a time and financial commitment for this club. They are as follows:

- ~"Bailey Dance Company" will meet as a "club" during our regularly scheduled Bronco Block time, which will be during our school day Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday from 9:15am-9:40am. Due to the demands of effectively warming up and learning choreography, our club may occasionally meet BEFORE SCHOOL HOURS some Tuesdays & Thursdays starting at 8:00am-8:30am, HOWEVER, this will not be all year long. I will send out an exact schedule of "early days" after the auditions have taken place. IF you are concerned about the earlier arrival and need assistance with transportation, I can help connect you with a family that may be able to assist you with a carpool.
- ~ There will be in and out of school performances. We will have a calendar set within the first two weeks our club begins, but initially I can tell you we will participate in our November Veteran's Day program in school, the Holiday Dance Showcase & Silent Auction on Friday, December 13th 6:00-8:30pm, the possible NCASA dance competition on Saturday, February 7th, 2020, participation in our International Night, National Dance Week, & Dance A Thon, along with other in-school events. Our dance program as a whole is forever evolving so the schedule may vary & is subject to change.
- ~ Students are required to have a Bailey Dance Company jacket, and costumes will be purchased, so you can expect an approximate \$75-\$100 investment for first year students, \$50-\$75 investment for second year members, and \$25-\$50 for third year members. All students will be required to have tan and/or black jazz shoes, lyrical shoes (adage turner or similar style), and a dance sneaker such as converse, split sole sneaker, etc. Class will require students to be dressed and READY TO DANCE every class unless instructed otherwise. Please come to school ready to move!
- ~ Attendance is imperative during our assigned club time, and I ask that if you know you will be out to please let me know in advance, however, I realize illness and emergencies arise. Direct communication from the student to me is very important, and followed up by communication from a parent/guardian is also helpful. **3 Unexcused absences will result in student being removed from the club.
